

Get ready for TitlePoint 3.4 by installing the new Microsoft .NET Framework version 3.5

Available to TitlePoint users in April, 2009



Install Microsoft .NET Framework before April 1

TitlePoint version 3.4, now in testing, will be available to users in April, which allows time to schedule the .NET Framework update. Alert your IT Support organization that TitlePoint 3.4 requires a .NET version 3.5 update and ask them to confirm that it is installed and functioning before April 1.

Property Insight continues to improve TitlePoint[®], the industry-leading title search and workflow application. Release 3.4 contains enhancements that improve performance and stability, but before the upgrade you must install version 3.5 of .NET Framework from Microsoft[®].

Enhancements to TitlePoint version 3.4

TitlePoint will no longer time-out with no warning. After 60 minutes of inactivity, a session expiration pop-up message alerts you when your session is about to expire and provides you the option to continue to use the application or sign out.

Automatically launch an Instrument or Name search from the property chain. Right-click a record to Search Instrument w/References, Launch from Instrument (search page) or Search this Reference. Clicking on a record's party name link will initiate a name search or use the magnifying glass next to the party name to launch from the search page.

Duplicate search results shared by different properties no longer display when you choose Future, Underlying or Related Parcels for a series or range of Tax Searches.

Documents that share the same property description for on-screen and printed Property Search results and that display in retrieval sequence or are sorted by legal description are now separated by dark lines.

TitlePoint employs Microsoft's .NET Framework, which provides a stable environment for maintaining and improving the product's functionality and compatibility with the new 64-bit generation of computers using Microsoft Windows[®]. The new .NET 3.5 release includes components that are critical to TitlePoint's iView and iPrint functionality.
