

## Get ready for TitlePoint Xpress 3.4 by installing the new Microsoft .NET Framework version 3.5

Available to TitlePoint Xpress users in April, 2009



### Install Microsoft .NET Framework before April 1

TitlePoint Xpress version 3.4, now in testing, will be available to users in April, which allows time to schedule the .NET Framework update. Alert your IT Support organization that TitlePoint Xpress 3.4 requires a .NET version 3.5 update and ask them to confirm that it is installed and functioning before April 1.

Property Insight continues to improve TitlePoint Xpress<sup>®</sup>, the title search, image retrieval and production workflow application. Release 3.4 contains enhancements that improve performance and stability, but before the upgrade you must install version 3.5 of .NET Framework from Microsoft<sup>®</sup>.

#### Enhancements to TitlePoint Xpress version 3.4

Search performance is improved in the new TitlePoint Xpress release. Now, users can more quickly navigate to the initial search results screen as well as between results screens from different searches.

TitlePoint Xpress will no longer time-out with no warning. After 60 minutes of inactivity, a session expiration pop-up message alerts you when your session is about to expire and provides you the option to continue to use the application or sign out.

References to unrelated documents have been removed, making title examinations easier while improving search performance. This enhancement is the result of improved search logic in the "Include References" option, which can be selected in the Preferences page. The new logic greatly reduces the number of documents returned that are unrelated to a search, such as a Master Assignment of Mortgage.

Also in the new version: when available, the Assessors Parcel Number and Case Number fields will be provided as separate fields in Expanded Search Results.

TitlePoint Xpress employs Microsoft's .NET Framework, which provides a stable environment for maintaining and improving the product's functionality and compatibility with the new 64-bit generation of computers using Microsoft Windows<sup>®</sup>. The new .NET 3.5 release includes components that are critical to TitlePoint Xpress's iView and iPrint functionality.
