

PROPERTY INSIGHT CALIFORNIA PRIVACY NOTICE

Property Insight (“our,” “us,” or “we”) respects and is committed to protecting your privacy. This California Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, and disclose Personal Information, when and to whom we disclose such information, and the rights you, as a California resident (“Consumer”), have regarding your Personal Information (“California Privacy Rights”). “Personal Information” means information that identifies, relates to, describes, and is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household. If Property Insight has collected, used, or disclosed your Personal Information in relation to a job application or employment, independent contractor, officer, owner, or director relationship with Property Insight, Property Insight’s practices are discussed in our Notice at Collection for Prospective Employees available at [Prospective California Employees](#).

Collection of categories of Personal Information:

In the preceding 12 months, Property Insight has collected, and will continue to collect, the following categories of Personal Information from you:

- Identifiers such as name, address, telephone number, IP address, email address, account name, social security number, driver’s license number, state identification card, financial information, date of birth, or other similar identifiers;
- Characteristics of protected classifications under California or Federal law;
- Commercial information, including records of personal property, products or services purchased, or other purchasing or consuming histories;
- Internet or other electronic network activity information including, but not limited to browsing history, search history, and information regarding a Consumer’s interaction with an Internet website or advertisement;
- Geolocation data;
- Unique biometric data used to authenticate a specific individual such as a fingerprint, retina, or iris image;
- Professional or employment information;
- Education Information.

This Personal Information is collected from the following sources:

- You or your agent on applications or other forms or from your transactions or interactions (including use of websites and mobile applications and engagement with advertisements);
- Third party advertising vendors, data analytics providers, internet service providers, and social networks;
- Property Insight, our affiliates, or others you have transacted with;
- Consumer reporting agencies and/or governmental entities, either directly from these entities or through others.

This Personal Information is collected for the following business purposes:

- To provide products and services to you or in connection with a transaction involving you;
- To advertise to you;
- To perform a contract between Property Insight and the Consumer;

- To improve our products and services;
- To comply with legal obligations;
- To detect and protect against fraudulent or illegal activity;
- To communicate with you about Property Insight or our affiliates;
- To maintain an account with Property Insight or our affiliates;
- To maintain the security of our systems, tools, accounts, and applications;
- To verify and authenticate identities and credentials;
- To provide support, personalize, and develop our websites, products, and services;
- To provide reviews and testimonials about our services, with your consent;
- As described to you when collecting your personal information or as otherwise permitted by the California Consumer Privacy Act.

Disclosures of Personal Information for a business purpose:

In the preceding 12 months, Property Insight has disclosed, and will continue to disclose, the categories of Personal Information listed above for a business purpose. We may disclose Personal Information for a business purpose to the following categories of third parties:

- Our affiliates and other Fidelity National Financial, Inc. (“FNF”) subsidiaries;
- Non-affiliated third parties, as directed or permitted by you;
- Businesses in connection with the sale or other disposition of all or part of the Property Insight business and/or assets;
- Service Providers and non-affiliated third parties such as data analytics providers;
- Law enforcement or authorities in connection with an investigation, or in response to a subpoena or court order.

Sale of Personal Information:

We may also provide your Personal Information to third parties, subject to your right to opt-out. In the preceding 12 months, as the terms are defined by the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA), as amended, Property Insight has “sold” the following categories of information:

- Internet or other electronic network activity information

Property Insight has “sold” the above categories of information collected from your activity on our websites to non-affiliated third parties such as internet service providers, data analytics providers, and social networks, to enable us to provide you with advertisements about our products and services on our websites and on third party websites. To opt-out of Personal Information “sales” visit Property Insight’s [Privacy Inquiry Website](#). Property Insight does not “sell” or “share” Sensitive Personal Information. Our Personal Information sales or sharing does not include information about individuals we know are under age 16.

Retention Periods:

Due to the breadth and variety of data collected by Property Insight, it is not possible for us to provide you with a comprehensive list of timeframes during which we retain each category of Personal Information. Property Insight retains categories of information as reasonably necessary to satisfy the purpose for which we collect the information. This time period varies depending on the purpose for which we collected the information, the nature and frequency of our interactions and relationship with you, whether we have a legal basis to continue retaining the information,

industry practices, the value and sensitivity of the information, and state and federal recordkeeping requirements.

Personal Information of minors:

Property Insight does not knowingly collect the Personal Information of minors.

Sensitive Personal Information:

Consumers have the right to limit the use or disclosure of their “Sensitive Personal Information” to just actions necessary to perform specific purposes listed in the CCPA, as amended. Sensitive Personal Information includes government identifiers (social security, driver’s license number or state ID, and passport number), precise geolocation, racial or ethnic origin, and other categories defined in California law. Property Insight does not use or disclose Sensitive Personal Information for any purposes other than those specified in the CCPA, as amended.

Right to know:

Consumers have a right to know about Personal Information collected, used, disclosed, shared, or sold, including the categories of such Personal Information, as well as the purpose for such collection, use, disclosure, sharing, or selling, categories of third parties to whom Personal Information is disclosed, shared or sold, and the specific pieces of Personal Information collected about the consumer. Consumers have the right to request Property Insight disclose what Personal Information it collected, used, and disclosed in the past 12 months.

Right to request deletion:

Consumers have a right to request the deletion of their personal information.

Right to Correct:

Consumers have the right to correct inaccurate Personal Information.

Right to non-discrimination:

Consumers have a right not to be discriminated against for exercising their consumer privacy rights. We will not discriminate against Consumers for exercising any of their California Privacy Rights.

Privacy Requests

Upon making a California Privacy Request, Property Insight will verify the consumer’s identity by requiring an account, loan, escrow number, or other identifying information from the consumer.

The above-rights are subject to any applicable rights and obligations including both federal and California exemptions rendering Property Insight, or Personal Information collected by Property Insight, exempt from certain CCPA requirements.

A Consumer may use an Authorized Agent to submit any CCPA request. Authorized agents' requests will be processed like any other CCPA request, but Property Insight will also require the Consumer provide the agent written permission to make the request and verify his or her identity with Property Insight.
